Lakewood City Council Adjourned Regular Meeting held May 28, 2024

MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER at 5:32 p.m. by Mayor Rogers in the Executive Board Room, 5000 Clark Avenue, Lakewood, California.

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MIXED USE DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE

In attendance were Andy Greenwood and Deena Henry of Macerich; Ken Hira and Joseph Dieguez of Kosmont Companies; and Jim Woods of Greystar Development.

Paul Kuykendall, Senior Planner, displayed slides and made a presentation on the mixed use ordinance highlighting the Regional Housing Needs Allocation (RHNA); Lakewood's RHNA Strategy; initial mixed use assumptions; drafting the mixed use ordinance; mixed use application contents; land uses; building height; building setbacks; minimum floor area; open space; on-site circulation; pedestrian standards; bicycle standards; vehicular circulation and driveways; parking standards; delivery and loading zones; fences and walls, trash and waste; operational standards; objective design standards; and signs.

Staff responded to questions and comments from Council Members regarding the lack of requirement for a traffic circulation study, restrictions on hours of construction, the application of existing building codes, SB9 conditions, resident input and community involvement.

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ENHANCED INFRASTRUCTURE FINANCING DISTRICT (EIFD)

Joseph Dieguez, Senior Vice President, Kosmont Companies, displayed slides and provided an introduction and background on the Enhanced Infrastructure Financing District as a financing strategy to capture the future value from new development. He reported that while a city-only special district could achieve favorable "return on investment" for the city, the County of Los Angeles had also indicated a willingness to be a financial partner further improving financial feasibility. He explained the next steps including preparation of an Infrastructure Financing Plan which required public notices and meetings/hearings.

Staff responded to questions and comments from Council Members pertaining to tangible benefits, capturing areas of potential growth and eligible uses of funding.

There being no further business to be brought before the City Council, Mayor Rogers adjourned the meeting at 7:15 p.m.
